## **“Initiative Workshop for Policy Development of Veterinary Ethics in Sri Lanka”**

A workshop on veterinary ethics titled “Initiative workshop for policy development of veterinary ethics in Sri Lanka” will be held from 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> July 2010 at the Institute for Continuing Education, Gannoruwa.

It aims to focus on building a dialogue on developing a veterinary ethics policy in Sri Lanka and this initiative is first of its kind in the country.

This workshop is organized by the Institute for Research & Development in collaboration with Royal Veterinary College (UK), University Federation for Animal Welfare (UK), Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Peradeniya and Department of Animal Production and Health.

Eminent resource persons in the field of animal welfare and veterinary ethics from the UK and Sri Lanka will be conducting the workshop. Prof. James Kirkwood, Prof. Neville Gregory, Dr Ayona Silva-Fletcher, Prof. Preeni Abeynayake and Dr A.D.N Chandrasiri are among these.

Participants were selected from the fields of animal welfare and veterinary medicine for the programme.
